#### CHOOSE ONE:

1. List some sexual problems men encounter before and during marriage. Take each of the problems you listed above and illustrate, with examples, how men might fall into these problems. In your essay, try to walk in the shoes of the fallen men and empathize with their situations. Offer solutions to their “problems,” recognizing them as sin, but showing a way each can recover from his sin.
2. Explain the covenants of the Bible from a scriptural perspective, including the covenant of marriage.
3. Imagine you have been invited to speak to 500 teenagers to convince them to keep themselves pure until marriage. Prepare an outline of what you would say, using Scripture references and emphasizing what points you would use to convince them.
